Travel north on Tramway from I-40 for 6.5 miles to San Rafael, NE (located between Academy and Paseo del Norte). East on San Rafael; CBI is the second property on the right.

Project is located on the southeast corner of Lomas and 2<sup>nd</sup> Street. From I-25 exit at Martin Luther King Blvd., proceed west to 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, turn north to Lomas.

Starting from I-25 and I-40, travel north on I-25 to the Alameda exit. Go west past the river to Corrales road. Go north to Camino Entrada (just past the Village Pizza) (approximately 3.5 miles) and turn right headed back towards the river. At the end of the road (approximately ¼ mile) is the house on the right hand side of the road.

From I-40 west exit north on Unser Blvd. Take Unser Blvd. north 5.2 miles At the top of the hill/escarpment (past Montano), turn right onto Molten Rock Road, then left onto Rimrock Circle. The Escarpment House is on the east side of the road.

Drive east on I-40 to the Cedar Crest exit. Drive north on Highway 14 continuing past the intersection with the Crest Road (State 536). From the intersection of the Crest Road to the entrance of San Pedro Overlook is approximately 5.7 miles. (If you get to Golden, NM you have gone too far!) Turn left and stop at the Gate House to San Pedro Overlook. Tell them you are attending the AIA Architecture Tour. After the gate, proceed on Turquoise Drive. Turn left at the second left hand turn onto Creekside Trail and proceed to the end of the cul-du-sac. Parking will be on the cul-du-sac and Creekside Trail.

Take second left onto Twin Tree Ct. House is at the end of the cul-de-sac down steep driveway on right. Park on the street and walk down driveway.

The University of New Mexico Tamarind Institute is located at the SE corner of the intersection of Stanford Drive and Central Avenue. Take the Central Ave. exit from I-25 (going either north or south on the freeway) and travel east, passing through the lights at Yale Blvd. and Cornell Drive. At the next light on Stanford Drive, take a right and then the next left to park in the UNM Tamarind Institute lot. There is also ample street parking in the area.
